The Performance Appraisal Report (PAR) for the Elementary(D.Ed) course for the session 2003-2004 submitted by you has been reviewed by the Southern Regional Committee.

Based on the PAR the intake of your institution for the session 2004-2005 has been fixed at 60 subject to the following conditions :

- All such teachers already appointed who do not fulfil the NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the NCTE norms.
- All teaching and non-teaching staff should be paid approved pay scales as per NCTE norms and the salary should be disbursed through the individual account payee cheques. The bank statement of the whole year should be submitted to the SRC-NCTE while submitting the Performance Appraisal Report.
- The management of the institution shall discharge the statutory obligations relating to pension, gratuity, provident fund etc. Proof for extending the same should be submitted along with the PAR .

The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Performance Appraisal Report. The performance appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated above.

PAR for the session 2004-2005 shall be sent to this office on or before 31st August 2005 failing which renewal of recognition for the same will not be considered.

Annexure enclosed should also be duly filled up with relevant information and sent along with the regular PAR for 2004-05.

In Teachers' Training Institutions with a minimum students attendance of 30 each in I year T.C.H. and II year T.C.H. Classes, following teaching posts and non-teaching posts may be sanctioned:

1. Principal/Superintendent - 1 (one)
2. Graduate Teacher Educators/Lecturers - 5 (five)
[Lecturer for General Subjects (1),
Lecturers in Methodology of teaching
school subjects (3) and Lecturer in
Educational Technology (1)]
3. Craft Teachers - 2 (two)
4. Part-time teachers to teach Kannada,
Hindi, Drawing, Music, Physical
Education, Tamil, Telugu, Urdu and
Marathi - 5 (five)
5. Second Division Clerk/Office Assistant - 1 (one)
6. Class IV - 1 (one)

Notes.—1. A part-time language teacher will have to be approved for each language with a minimum strength of 10.

2. For every additional section sanctioned, subject to the provisions of clause (d) of Rule 10 of Grant-in-Aid Code for Primary Teachers' Training Institutions, one additional Graduate Teacher Educator/Lecturer will be admitted, where the workload, warrants the appointment of a full time teacher in place of part-time teacher, normally admissible as per the above pattern. Specific approval of the Director of Public Instruction (Research and Training) should be obtained before the full time appointment is actually made.

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Amendments to the uniform Grant-in-aid Code for Primary Teacher Training Institutions in Karnataka State.

The organisation, Society or Association shall be registered under the Mysore Societies Registration Act 1960. Not more than one member of a family shall be a member of the managing committee. No official of the Dept. shall be a member	The organization of a Private Educational Organisation, Society or Association shall be registered under the Mysore Societies Registration Act, 1960. There shall be a duly constituted Managing Committee to look after the administration of the Institution under a Private Educational Organisation, Society or Association. The Managing Committee shall consist of not less than 7 and not more than 15 persons who shall act in the capacity of trustees and shall be answerable for the maintenance of the institution and for the compliance of such rules as may be prescribed by the Dept. from time to time. Not more than one member of a family shall be a member of the Managing Committee.
